Dear Ms. Tilley:

Enclosed is your copy of the fully executed Programmatic Agreement for the referenced program. By carrying out the terms of the Agreement, you will fulfill your responsibilities under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) and the regulations of Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). The original Agreement will remain on file at our office.

We commend the Forest Service for working closely with the ACHP, the Tennessee and Kentucky State Historic Preservation Officers, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians, Eastern Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma, and numerous other consulting parties to develop this agreement to tailor the Section 106 review process for routine undertakings of the recreation area. The tailored process is designed to reduce paperwork and unnecessary time and effort by Forest Service staff and all the consulting parties so that all can work towards broader efforts to identify and evaluate historic properties throughout the recreation area in a manner consistent with the goals of Section 110 of the NHPA. Forest Service efforts to continue consultation with all parties will ensure that the lines of communication remain open.
