Providing 21st Century Recreation

High Speed Internet

High speed internet fiber optic cable connected to all developed facilities in the Tennessee portion of Land Between the Lakes

Vault Toilet Installation

Five vault toilets were installed. Three at Turkey Bay OHV Area, one at Cumberland Trailhead and one at Jenny Ridge Picnic Area. 80% of cost paid by Recreational Trails Program Grant from state of KY.

National Visitor Use Monitoring

Preparations for the Fiscal Year 2022 National Visitor Use Monitoring were completed and the survey began in Oct 2021.

Turkey Bay OHV Area

Completed installation of rider rest area, new picnic tables and dumpster pads. Completed widening of a portion of the main trail.

Canal Loop Trail

Replaced the O'Brien Bridge on the Canal Loop Trail.
